

How a love for children and families spurred the creation of a park.

"We've got to live with nature. The children have to feel the ground beneath them and go out in the woods and see the trees and birds."

This statement by Geraldine L. Thompson in the 1950s to a reporter was surely a vision of what was to come.

In the fall of 1961, Mrs. Thompson met with Monmouth County Freeholder Director Joseph Irwin to discuss her interest in donating her beloved Brookdale Farm in Lincroft for a county park. Shortly after that initial meeting, she spoke with another reporter and stated: "I would like nothing better than to know that Brookdale in the future would be an open place for children and for animals because they have a place here, too... I would want it to be under the control of the county and open to all."



A Brief History - Brookdale Farm

Native Americans had lived in this area for several thousand years when Dutch and English pioneers started settling Monmouth County in the late 17th century. By the 1780s, Thomas Lloyd, a prosperous landowner and tanner, acquired about 316 acres and built his house there in 1786. After the Civil War, wealthy businessmen established horse farms and estates in the area, and David Dunham Withers assembled 838 acres, which included the property of Lloyd's farm, to establish Brookdale Farm as one of the county's premiere thoroughbred breeding and training farms.

In 1893, Col. William Payne Thompson and his wife Mary Evelyn Moffett Thompson acquired Brookdale Farm, and hired a prominent trainer as well as increasing the stable to nearly 200 horses and expanding the farm's agricultural operations in hay, corn, carrots, cabbage and butter. In 1895, Thompson hired a renowned New York architectural firm to design a Colonial Revival mansion around the core of David Withers' house. William passed away in 1896, before its completion, leaving the farm to his wife in trust for their three children. The Thompson mansion was completed in 1898 with a total of 29 rooms, 14 fireplaces and 6 bathrooms.



William and Evelyn's son Lewis married Geraldine Livingston Morgan in 1896 and moved to Brookdale Farm. The couple had four children of their own and took in four nieces and nephews of Lewis's after his sister passed away as well as a young cousin of his. Brookdale Farm thus resounded with both children and horses in the first decades of the 20th century. While Lewis tended to business and hunting, Geraldine became prominent in politics, public health reform, social services, and philanthropy.

"An Open Place for Children..."

The park began with the generous 215-acre donation from Mrs. Thompson and has thrived and grown ever since. The park is now a total of 667 acres and is home to the Monmouth County Park System's Headquarters and many of Brookdale Farm's buildings are still standing:



- The original Lewis Thompson house serves as the Headquarters building where you'll find our Administrative, Human Resources, and Registration staff.
- The farm's former Ten Mare Barn now serves as garage and storage space for Thompson Park's maintenance operations, and the Yearling Barn serves as the park's Theater Barn.
- Thomas Lloyd's Georgian style house had been the largest house in Middletown Township when recorded in a 1798 tax assessment. During the Brookdale Farm years, the house served as the Horse Trainer's residence, and today it is home to the Park System's Acquisition and Design offices.
- Sadly, the Thompson Mansion suffered a fire 2006 that led to its reconstruction, which was done in the same Colonial Revival style. The house is the park's Visitor Center and is home to a historic exhibit about the site, multiple program rooms, and offices for staff members.

Today, Thompson Park with its playgrounds, miles of trails, lake for fishing and boating, open fields, a creative arts center, and wide variety of programs, summer camps and events would surely make Geraldine Thompson proud. Be sure to celebrate the Park System's 60th anniversary by visiting Thompson Park and other Monmouth County parks throughout the year.





Program Refunds/Fees

Refund Policy

1. A full refund will be given when a program or trip is canceled by the Monmouth County Park System.

2. No refunds or credits will be given for any sessions missed by the participant.
3. If adequate advance notice is provided, we will refund the full amount of the program less a processing fee and non-recoverable expenses, as listed below. If we are able to replace you on a program prior to the program's start, you will receive a full refund less a processing fee as noted below.

- General program or one-day trip: full refund with at least 10 calendar days advance notice, less \$5 processing fee and any nonrecoverable expenses (pre-paid meals, lodging, tickets, etc.)
- Multi-day bus/van trip or ticketed day trip: full refund with at least 45 calendar days advance notice, less a \$25 processing fee and any non-recoverable expenses (pre-paid meals, lodging, tickets.etc.)
- Camps: full refund with at least 30 calendar days advance notice, less a \$25 processing fee and any non-recoverable expenses (prepaid meals, lodging, tickets); 50% refund with 14 to 29 calendar days advance notice, less a \$25 processing fee and any nonrecoverable expenses; no refund within 13 calendar days of the start of the camp.
